Bordentown City Added to the BoatUS National Fishing Line Recycling Program



In the last two years The BoatUS Foundation's "Reel in and Recycle" program built and distributed nearly 1,200 fishing line recycling bins to local groups around the country. These three-foot tall PVC storage tubes keep discarded fishing line out of our waterways and helps protect fish, birds and other wildlife from entanglement.

The Bordentown Beach, the local Yacht Clubs and areas along the Crosswicks Creek all attract large numbers of fishermen. In order to help them safely recycle their used and tangled fishing line Bordentown City has joined in BoatUS's and the NJ State Department of Environmental

Protection's efforts by installing three collection units (see photo) at the beach. The local yacht clubs will also be installing some on their property.

The line collected by the City will be sent to Berkley Conservation Institute, a division of Pure Fishing, for recycling where it is melted down and used to make other products.

New Canal Bridge is Open

The new bridge is complete, opening up foot and bike traffic from Bordentown City across the D&R canal all the way to Trenton. Just go to the end of Farnsworth Ave., cross the River Line bridge and follow the trail. The bridge is just part of the long-planned Delaware River Heritage Trail:

The Delaware River Heritage Trail will be a 60-mile multi-use loop highlighting the cultural and natural resources along the upper portion of the scenic Delaware River estuary. The completed trail will link 24 communities, from Trenton to Palmyra on the New Jersey side and from Morrisville to Philadelphia's Tacony neighborhood in Pennsylvania.
