The Bordentown City maintenance crew, members of the Environmental Commission, the Kiwanis Club, and local volunteers recently put in some hard labor to start getting our new parks in shape.



Trees were trimmed and chipped (for placement on the trails). Old lumber lining the Lime Kiln trail was removed (recent flooding had done some damage) to make way for new ties that will be anchored permanently. Several tons of stone was delivered for a parking area at lime kiln, and new split-rail fences will soon be ready for installation.

A special thank you goes out to our local Kiwanis Club for the large number of volunteers they supplied. They are

In March, 15 local residents participated in a Rain Barrel Workshop sponsored by the BCEC and the Rutgers Cooperative Extension. Collected rain water provides an alternative to using our drinking water supply for gardening, etc. - And helps prevent storm-water from delivering pollution to our local waterways.
