### Projects that will be done on a continual basis:

- 1) Quarterly Newsletter
- 2) Exhibit at Street Fair (May) and Cranberry Festival (October)
- 3) Maintain the BCEC web site
- 4) Work with volunteers on projects

#### **Top Tier Projects**

- 1) Establish an educational and events committee. Tasks include:
  - series of walks, rides and field trips
  - work on a speakers series
  - talks on organic lawn care and pest management
  - develop a safe biking program
  - establish a school environmental program
  - · develop walking maps/guides around Bordentown City
  - establish a film series
  - arrange a presentation on organic farming
- 2) Establish a committee for Oliver Street Park. The committee will work with city commission, officials, and other city organizations to develop a plan for the park.
- 3) Develop a plan for a Thorntown Creek Trail
- 4) Write environmental and open space grants for the City

#### **Middle Tier Projects**

- 1) Promote backyard wildlife habitats
- 2) Establish a recycling committee
- 3) Work on Blacks Creek Greenway
- 4) Promote cleanup programs, including:
  - adopt a stream
  - adopt a park
  - cleanups of streams, streets, or other areas as appropriate
- 5) Develop historic interpretive signs
