Details for Reserving a Garden Plot

- **Plot Size:** Each plot is 6 ft. x 11 ft.
- **Plot Cost:** Cost for 1 plot is \$25 (*You can purchase multiple plots if available.*)
- **Availability:** Garden plots will be distributed based on a first come first serve of interested people. If you do not receive a plot, we will put you on a waitlist to be notified when a plot becomes available. Preference will be given to City Residents.
- **Growing Season:** April 2016 thru October 2016
- **What does the \$25 plot fee include:** The \$25 plot fee is an annual fee that pays for common expenses including maintenance and water. Gardeners provide their own tools, plants, seeds, soil amendments, and any other supplies.
